	6. This is NOT mandatory but it will help! — See if you have some sort of photography editing software like Photoshop or Lightroom. If you do not have these, then try Picaso or Photoshop Lightroom for tablets (Picaso is free. There are many free software packages that will work for this class. (If you are using a Smart Phone you may have capabilities that will work for enhancing photographs).  Competence with editing software is not necessary for this course, but it can help you — the key is saving the file as a Jpeg format all the time. Make sure you investigate this in the first week.
